

Peacock Tile Scene



One of the best ways to showcase big, beautiful embroidered art is with a tile scene. Our number one request for tile scenes is to create one that can be displayed all year. Well, here it is! As you know, peacocks are large birds and it is very hard to get all of the detail from their feathers into a 6"x10" hoop, so we decided to create a jumbo scene. The large scene allows all of the beautiful detail of the peacock to really come through with thread. This is a 20 block tile scene that comes in three different sizes, a small size for the 5"x7" hoop a medium size for the 6"x10" hoop and a large size for the 7"x12" hoop. A premium feature of this tile scene, the background stippling, is built into the embroidery design so you don't have to add it later. As far as tile scenes go, this one has among the least amount of colors in it and uses the least amount of fabric. We hope you enjoy this beautiful collection and it is easy to embroider with our step-by-step tutorial.


Peacock Tile Scene

20 Block Tile Scene in 3 Sizes

A: You will need a hoop that can embroider 4.8" x 4.8" for size "A" - (finished project measures 24" wide by 19" tall)

B: You will need a hoop that can embroider 5.8" x 5.8" for size "B" - (finished project measures 29" wide by 23" tall)

C: You will need a hoop that can embroider 6.8" x 6.8" for size "C" - (finished project measures 34" wide by 27" tall)
