


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## Dingo II

ITEM NO.: K7905 Teak

K7911 Ash White



Read the instructions carefully before starting. Please open and inspect the contents of boxes to see that all parts are included. You will need a Phillips head and a flat head screwdriver. A power screwdriver or cordless drill is preferable. Ensure that the Phillips head fits neatly and fully engages the screw to avoid damage to the screws. Make sure that you tighten all screws securely and tap wooden dowels all the way in.

#### Use and Care


Your cabinet normally requires a minimum amount of maintenance; however, the following points are worth noting:

**Cleaning** - To remove marks and enhance the surface, wipe with general purpose cleaner.


Caution - Do not use ammonia-based cleaning agents. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleansers. The surface can be wiped with a damp cloth but should be dried quickly.

**Electrical and Hydraulic Lifts** - Require annual lubrication.


#### Understanding How the Cam Fastener Works




Screw cam bolts flush as illustrated.



surface. The arrow direction must be in the direction of the hole!




hole in edge of panel.

#### Step 1. Panel G assembly.

- 1. Fix casters **t2** to panel **G** with bolts **b1** as illustrated below using wrench **a** to tighten.
- 2. Turn panel over to side with care.
- 3. Install cam bolts **c1** into panel **G** as illustrated below.




Locking Plate Caster **x5**

#### Step 2. Preparation Panels A, X, Z, Y and D


- 1. Insert cams bolts **c1** into panels **A**, **X**, **Z** and **D** as illustrated below.
- 2. Insert dowel pins **d1** to panels **X**, **Z**, **Y** and **D** as illustrated below.
- 3. Attach Lock plate Lx2 to panel A using screws s1 as illustrated below.








#### Step 3. Panels D, Y, X, and Z assembly.


Insert cam bolts **c1** on panels **Y**, **X** and **Z** into cams on panel **D** and tighten in a clockwise direction as illustrated below. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.





#### Step 4. Panel G assembly.

- 1. Unscrew and remove the bottom drawer runners from panels **X**, **Y** and **Z** for access to cams.
- 2. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **G** into cams on panels **X**, **D**, **Y** and **Z** and tighten in a clockwise direction.
- 3. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.




Step 5. Flip cabinet over.






#### Step 6. Panel A assembly.

- 1. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **A** into cams on panels **X**, **D**, **Y** and **Z** and tighten in a clockwise direction.
- 2. Reinstall lower drawer runners on panels **X**, **Y** and **Z**.
- 3. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.

Step 7. Preparation Panels 01, 02, V1 and V2


1. Fix hinge bodies **g1** to panels **V1** and **V2** with screws **s1** as illustrated below.

2. Fix locks L to panels V1 and V2 with screws s3 as illustrated below.



#### Step 8. Door Panels V1 and V2 assembly.


1. Attach **V1** and **V2** door assembly using hinge bodies **g1** with screws **s1** to panels **X** and **Z** as illustrated below.





#### Step 9. Panels 01 and 02 assembly.

- 1. Locate the pilot holes for hinges on back panel **D**. Fix hinges on **O1** to **D** using 3 **s1** screws per hinge.
- 2. Locate pilot holes and fix hinges on **02** to **D** using 3 **s1** screws per hinge.






Step 10. Preparation Panels L, K, K1, K2, K3, K4, K5, K6, K7 and K8

- 1. Insert cam bolts c1 into panels L, K, K1, K2, K3, K4, K5, K6 and K7 as illustrated below.
- 2. Insert dowel pins d1 into panels K1, K2, K3, K5, K6, K7 and K8 as illustrated below.









#### Step 11. Drawer(s) Panel L, L1, L2, L3 and L4 assembly.

- 1. Slide bottom panel **L4** into **L**, **L1**, **L2** slots.
- 2. Insert cam bolts c1 on panel L into cam on panels L1 and L2. Tighten cams clockwise.
- 3. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.
- 4. Insert screws **s2** on panels **L1** and **L2** inside panel **L3** as illustrated. Screws will create the holes in panel **L3** so line up carefully.



#### Step 12. Panel K, K1, K2, K3 and K8 assembly.


- 1. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **K3** back into cams on panel **K8** bottom. Tighten in clockwise direction.
- 2. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panels **K1** and **K2** sides into cams on panel **K8** bottom and **K3** back. Tighten cams in clockwise direction. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.
- 3.Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **K** front into cams on panel **K8** bottom and sides **K1** and **K2**. Tighten cams in clockwise direction.






#### Step 13. Panel K4, K5, K6, K7 and K8 assembly.

- 1. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **K7** back into cams on panel **K8** bottom. Tighten in clockwise direction.
- 2. Insert cam bolts c1 on panels K5 and K6 sides into cams on panel K8 bottom and K7 back. Tighten cams in clockwise direction. Apply cam covers **c2** over tightened cams.
- 5/8" Cam Cover **x16** 3. Insert cam bolts **c1** on panel **K4** front into cams on panel **K8** bottom and sides **K5** and K6. Tighten cams in clockwise direction.

When you request warranty service, you must also present proof of purchase documentation, which includes the date of purchase (detailed receipt), and photos of the product. Arrow will replace any defective part (at its sole option), excluding labor. Replacement parts will be warranted for only the remaining period of the original Warranty.

Replacement parts will be shipped freight prepaid on any initial warranty claim during first year of Warranty only. Warranty applies only to defects confirmed by Arrow Companies, LLC and will be replaced or repaired at Arrow's option. In the event parts are no longer available for a warranty claim, customer may receive brand new cabinet at a price equal to 60% off the MSRP of a current comparable model.


