# **Yo-Yo Christmas Trees**



This homemade holiday décor is quick and easy using the Baby Lock Journey. Use traditional fabrics or new colors for a modern look. Top the trees with standalone embroidery done entirely on the Journey.

## Supplies:

Baby Lock® Journey sewing and embroidery machine

4-5 Christmas fat quarters

White felt

Small, Large and Jumbo Clover Quick Yo-Yo Makers

Madeira® embroidery threads

Tear-away stabilizer from Baby Lock

Temporary spray adhesive

9" round Styrofoam base

3 Christmas colored small spools of thread for trunks of trees

### At the Embroidery Machine:

Create three designs for the top of the trees.

- 1. Set the machine up for embroidery.
- 2. Select Embroidery Edit.
- 3. Select the Exclusive icon.
- 4. Select the Celebrate category.
- 5. On the first page, select either the second or the third snowflake design on the top row.
- 6. Click on Set.
- 7. Tap on the Embroidery icon.
- 8. Select the Monochrome button to remove the color stops. This icon has a line under a spool of thread. Now the machine will not stop for color changes. This will allow you to use only one color for the design.
- 9. Hoop the stabilizer and spray with the temporary spray adhesive.
- 10. Place a piece of the felt in the center of the hoop and finger press to secure.
- 11. Place the hoop on the machine.
- 12. Embroider the design.
- 13. Glue a section of felt to the backside of the star and trim away excess felt around the outer edge of the design.

#### Hand Work:

- Follow the Clover Quick Yo-Yo Makers manufacturer's directions for making Yo-Yo's from the Christmas fabrics. For the tall skinny tree, use the large and small Yo-Yo Makers. For the medium and large trees, use all three sizes. Make the jumbo sized Yo-Yos first and work your way up the tree. Each of the trees used approximately 15-20 Yo-Yos.
- 2. Cover the 9" styrofoam base with one of the Christmas fabrics.
- 3. Glue the largest Yo-Yos to the top on each of the spools of thread. Continue up the tree gluing each of the units to the prior Yo-Yo unit until you finish with the smallest Yo-Yo placed at the top.
- 4. Glue the embroidered star to the top of each tree. Place a star point inside the opening on the Yo-Yo and glue in place.
- 5. To secure the trees, glue the trees to the covered 9" styrofoam base.
