	<b>Straight stitch</b> – The all-purpose stitch with a length of up to 5 mm and 24 needle positions.	•	•	•
	<b>Straight stitch with automatic back-tack</b> at the start of each seam.		•	•
	<b>Basting stitch</b> – Basting by machine, the fast way to your first fitting.			•
	<b>Stretch triple straight stitch</b> – For reinforcing heavily strained seams.	•	•	•
	<b>Stem stitch</b> – For outstanding topstitching.	•	•	•
	<b>Zigzag stitch</b> – Indispensable for overcasting seams, appliqué and patchwork (up to 7 mm wide).	•	•	•
	<b>Elastic blind hem</b> – Invisible hem finish on stretch fabrics.	•	•	•
	<b>Blind hem</b> – The fast, invisible way to secure seams. Also used as decorative finish on fine fabrics.	•	•	•

	<b>Decorative overedge stitch</b> – Sews and finishes fine, stretchy fabrics in one simple step.	•	•	•
	<b>Triple zigzag stitch</b> – Highly elastic stitch, ideal for sportswear and swimsuits.	•	•	•
	<b>Decorative triple zigzag stitch</b> – For decorative seams or topstitching on stretch fabrics.	•	•	•
