Class description	<p>Paula has had many requests for a multi-day machine quilting workshop. In this two day class, you will learn to handle the bulk of a quilt while sewing on a home machine! In this Hands-On class, you will work on larger quilt tops instead of a small sample and be able to practice techniques instead of visualize them.</p>
Supply list	<p>QUILTS AND SANDWICHES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IMPORTANT – your quilt must be pin basted when you bring it to class! There is not time or space to baste in the classroom. • Lap or Twin sized quilt, pin basted with small (size 1) basting pins using a low loft batting such as Warm & Natural or Quilter's Dream Cotton. For ease of basting, make sure that your batting and backing are both at least 4" longer and 4" wider than your quilt top. Do Not Mark your quilt top. • Three Muslins 'sandwich' (2 pieces of muslin 20" square with a piece of low-loft cotton batting between them. (light fabrics is important) <p>GENERAL SEWING SUPPLIES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thread in colors compatible with your quilt top

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monofilament thread in clear and/or smoke (• Matching or contrasting thread for your muslin sandwiches (your preference, although dark thread on light fabric is somewhat humbling) • Water soluble marker such as Wonder by Collins or Mark B Gone • Straight pins • Seam ripper • Small scissors or thread snips • Extra safety pins — use small ones; large pins tend to poke holes in fabric • Extra sewing machine needles, size 80/12 (Schmetz denim needles work very well)
