



ALL ABOUT the open toe foot

Better visibility, makes the open toe foot one of the most practical feet available for your sewing machine. Use this foot for all satin stitching as well as any technique where you really need to see exactly where you are sewing.

The center mark (1) helps you keep the stitching straight, turn corners easily, or guide your stitching such as in hemstitching. The wide cut-out area (2) on the bottom allows the satin stitching to flow under the foot without catching.

For turning inside corners, align the center mark along the edge of the fabric. Once you have reached the corner, stitch beyond the corner approximately the width of the sewn satin stitch. Pivot the fabric, aligning the mark with the edge again before starting to stitch. For outside corners, stitch to the corner.

Lower the needle on the right side and pivot. Align the mark on the foot with the edge of the fabric before sewing.
