

ALL ABOUT the roller foot

The roller foot is the answer for sewing on delicate, slippery or "sticky" fabrics such as velvet, vinyl, leather or other similar fabrics.

The rollers (1) located on the front and back help move the fabric under the foot providing an upper feeding system without marking the delicate fabrics as other feet might.

It is always best to test sew on a scrap of fabric before sewing your project. The roller foot often is interchangeable with the Teflon coated foot for similar types of fabrics. Try both to see which works best on the fabric selected.



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Increase or decrease the presser foot pressure to help the roller foot feed the fabric through.

Use a piece of tissue paper on top of "sticky" fabric to help it feed under the foot more easily.
