

ALL ABOUT the Teflon coated foot

The Teflon coated foot is just the foot to use when sewing difficult fabrics that don't want to feed smoothly under the standard presser foot. The special Teflon coating on the bottom (1) helps the fabrics, such as vinyl, oilcloth, leather, or suede, glide under the foot more easily.

Test sewing on difficult fabrics using both the Teflon coated foot as well as the roller foot. You may find that each foot handles each fabric differently. Choose the one that performs the best for your project.

The Teflon coated foot has a needle opening wide enough to handle both straight and zigzag stitching.
