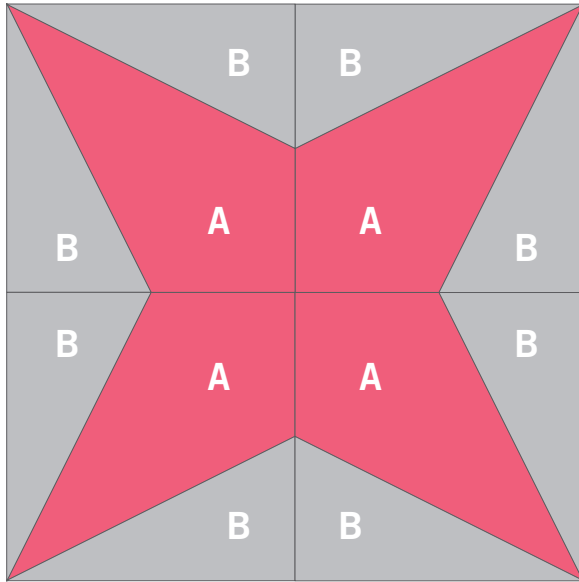

Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 8" finished Kite block:

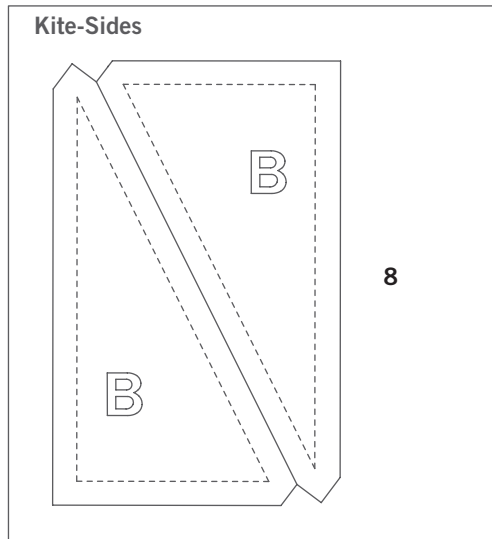
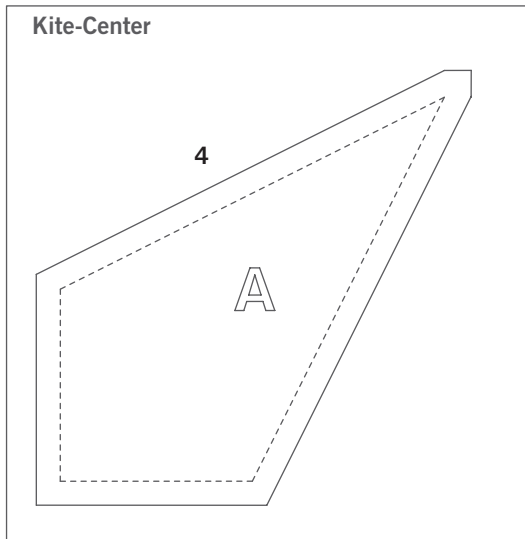


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Cover shape A with four layers of one fabric color and shape B with four layers of a contrasting fabric color and cut.

- **Kite-Center:** Cut a 5" strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 5" widths. Place on selected blade and cut. Cut eight kite centers across the width of fabric. One yard of 40" wide fabric cuts 56 kite centers.
- **Kite-Sides:** Cut a 3½" strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 5⅛" widths. Place on selected blade and cut. Cut 14 kite sides across the width of fabric. One yard of 40" wide fabric cuts 140 kite sides.

Shapes needed for 8" finished Kite Block



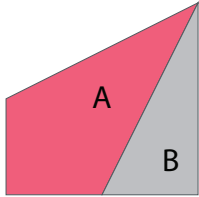

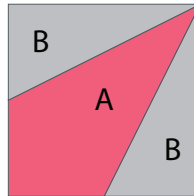
How to Sew the Kite Quilt Block:

Step 1



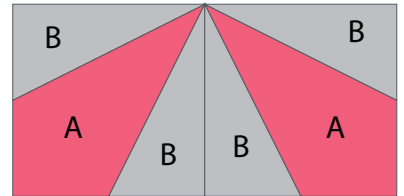
Sew piece B to piece A as shown. Make four.

Step 2



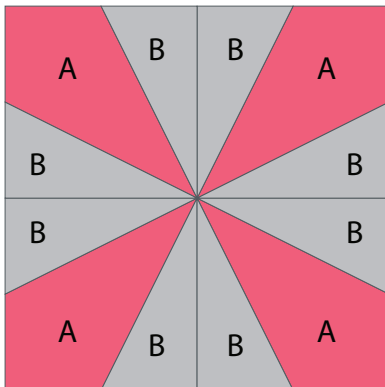
Sew a second piece B to the opposite side of the A/B units to make quarter blocks.

Step 3



Sew two quarter blocks together as shown to make a half block. Make two.

Step 4



Sew half blocks together to complete the block.
