Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 18" finished Carpenter's Wheel block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (pink): For 16 A shapes: Cut three $23^{1 / 8 "} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes A to cut. (There will be two extra shapes.)
- Fabric Color 2 (dark pink): For 8 A shapes: Cut one $23^{1 / 81} \times 2^{7 / 81}$ rectangle. Place right side up over shapes $A$ to cut. Cut two extra shapes by placing a $91 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle over two A shapes to cut.


## - Fabric Color 3 (teal):

- For 8 A shapes: Cut one $23^{1 / 18 " ~} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ rectangle. Place right side up over shapes A to cut. Cut two extra shapes by placing a $9^{1 / 8 "} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ rectangle over two $A$ shapes to cut.
- For 8 B shapes: Cut one $11^{1 / 4 "} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Place right side up over shapes B to cut. Cut two extra shapes by placing one 4 " square over two $B$ shapes to cut.
- Fabric Color 4 (yellow): For 16 B shapes: Cut three $11 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes B to cut.(There will be two extra shapes.)
- Fabric Color 5 (gray):
- For 8 B shapes: Cut one $11 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 4$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shapes B to cut. Cut two extra shapes by placing one 4 " square over two $B$ shapes to cut.
- For 8 C shapes: Cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place right side up over shapes C to cut.
- For 16 D shapes: Cut four $61 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 4 " ~ r e c t a n g l e s . ~ P l a c e ~ r i g h t ~ s i d e ~ u p ~ o v e r ~ s h a p e s ~}$ D to cut.

How to Sew the 5-color, 18" finished Carpenter's Wheel Block:
*1) It's a good idea to lay out the block pieces before you start sewing. 2) This block's quarter units include shapes that mirror each other. If your block includes fabrics that need to face a certain way, you will need to fanfold your fabric on the die when cutting those shapes. 3) Press $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams open unless otherwise noted in the pattern.

Step 1


Sew 2 A pieces and $3 B$ pieces together in colors as shown to make right facing $A / B / A / B / B$ unit.

Make 4 units.

Step 4


Sew piece $A$ and $D$, then add $B$ as shown to make right facing $A / B / D$ unit. Then follow the same steps to make left facing $A / B / D$ unit. Make 4 units of each.

Step 2


Sew 2 A pieces and 3 B pieces together in colors as shown to make left facing $A / B / A / B / B$ unit. Make 4 units.

Step 5


Sew C/A/D unit (from step 3) to $A / B / D$ unit (from step 4) as shown. Make 4 right facing units and 4 left facing units.

Step 3


Sew piece $C$ and $A$, then add $D$ as shown to make right facing C/A/D unit. Then follow the same steps to make left facing C/A/D unit. Make 4 units of each.

Step 6

Sew A/B/A/B/B unit (from steps 1 \& 2) to $C / A / D / A / B / D$ unit (from step 5) as shown. Make 4 right facing units and 4 left facing units.


## Step 7

LEFT


Sew together the two units (from step 6). Make 4 quarter units.

## Step 8



Sew quarter units into rows, then sew rows together. Block should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
