Fabric Cutting Tips for a 4-color, 12" finished Arkansas Traveler block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain
(straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is
specially designed to cut one 4-color, 12 " block in one pass
through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1: Cut one $73 / 4$ " $\times 53 / 4$ " rectangle and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 2: Cut one $73 / 4$ " $\times 53 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 3: Cut two $73 / 4$ " $\times 53 / 4^{1 "}$ rectangles and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 4: Cut four $6^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{7 / 8 "}$ rectangles and place over shape $B / B R$ and cut. Cut four 7 " $\times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles and place over shape $C$ and cut.

Shapes needed for 12" finished Arkansas Traveler


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How to Sew the Arkansas Traveler Quilt Block:

Step 1


Sew three colors of A pieces together as shown to make A/A units.

## Step 4



Sew piece $B R$ to $A / A / A / A / B$ unit as shown. Make four BR/A/A/A/A/B units.

Step 2


Sew two A/A units together as shown. Make four A/A/A/A units.

## Step 5



Sew piece $C$ to $B R / A / A / A / A / B$ unit as shown. Make four C/BR/A/A/A/A/B units.

## Step 3



Sew piece $B$ to $A / A / A / A$ unit as shown. Make four $A / A / A / A / B$ units.

## Step 6



Sew two C/BR/A/A/A/A/B units together to create half blocks. Make two.

Step 7


Sew two half blocks together to complete block.
