



Fabric Cutting Tips for a 4-color, 12" finished Arkansas Traveler block:





Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:


For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one 4-color, 12" block in one pass through the cutter.


- Fabric Color 1: Cut one 7¾" x 5¾" rectangle and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 2: Cut one 7¾" x 5¾" rectangle and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 3: Cut two 73/4" x 53/4" rectangles and place over shape A and cut.
- Fabric Color 4: Cut four 6" x 37%" rectangles and place over shape B/BR and cut. Cut four 7" x 41/4" rectangles and place over shape C and cut.

Shapes needed for 12" finished Arkansas Traveler












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
How to Sew the Arkansas Traveler Quilt Block:

Step 1




Sew three colors of A pieces together as shown to make A/A units.

Step 4




Sew piece BR to A/A/A/B unit as shown. Make four BR/A/A/A/A/B units.

Step 7




Sew two half blocks together to complete block.

Step 2




Sew two A/A units together as shown. Make four A/A/A/A units.

Step 5




Sew piece C to BR/A/A/A/A/B unit as shown. Make four C/BR/A/A/A/A/B units.

Step 3



Sew piece B to A/A/A/A unit as shown. Make four A/A/A/B units.

Step 6



Sew two C/BR/A/A/A/A/B units together to create half blocks.

Make two.
