

Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 6" finished Spool block:





Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. For three complete 3-color blocks, cut two layers of three different fabric colors at a time.

• Cut 10½" strips across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 4" widths. Place on selected blade and cut. For a three-color design, 10 cuts across the width of fabric of one color will yield enough pieces for five complete blocks. One yard of 40" wide fabric in each color will yield 15 blocks.

How to Sew the Spool Quilt Block:

Step 1


Sew four D rectangles in coordinating colors to make a Thread Unit.

Step 2




Sew one B Half Square Triangle (HST) onto either side of one A trapezoid to make a Spool Unit. Make two.

Step 3




Sew one C rectangle onto either side of one Thread Unit.


Step 4



Sew two Spool Units onto the top and bottom of one Thread Unit to complete the Spool Block.
