Shapes needed for 6" finished Spider Web Quarter Unit

## Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

Note: Find directions for a 12"Finished Spider Web block on next page.
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. For 2-color unit, cut two layers of one fabric color and two layers of a contrasting fabric color at a time.

- Cut two $81 / 2$ " $\times 4$ " rectangles. Place one layer of fabric and one contrasting layer of fabric right side up over shapes $A, B, C$ and $D$ to cut shapes.
- Cut two 6" $\times 4$ " rectangles. Place one layer of fabric and one contrasting layer of fabric wrong side up over shapes $B, C$ and $D$ to cut shapes.
- For a two-color design, 10 cuts across the width of fabric yield enough pieces for five complete blocks; and one yard of 40" wide fabric in each color will yield 20 blocks.

Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 12" finished Spider Web block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
Each Spider Web block is composed of four 6" finished units for a 12" finished block. You can cut an entire 12" finished block in 4 passes through the cutter.
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. For 2-color unit, cut two layers of one fabric color and two layers of a contrasting fabric color at a time.

- Cut two $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place one layer of fabric and one contrasting layer of fabric right side up over shapes A, B, C and D to cut shapes.
- Cut two 6" $\times 4$ " rectangles. Place one layer of fabric and one contrasting layer of fabric wrong side up over shapes B, C and D to cut shapes.
- For a two-color design, 10 cuts across the width of fabric yield enough pieces for five complete blocks; and one yard of 40" wide fabric in each color will yield 20 blocks.

## Step 1



Sew piece $A$ to piece $B$.

Step 5


Sew piece $C$ to $B / A / B / C / D$.

Step 2


Sew piece $C$ to piece $A / B$.

Step 3


Sew piece $D$ to piece $A / B / C$.

Step 4


Sew piece $B$ to piece $A / B / C / D$.

Step 6


Sew piece $D$ to piece
C/B/A/B/C/D.

Step 7


Sew two half blocks together to complete block.
