Fabric Cutting Tips for one 4-color, 12" finished Whirling Star block:


Shapes needed for 12" finished Whirling Star

Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 4-color 12 " block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1 (orange):
- Cut two 55/8" squares. Place right side up over shapes A to cut 4 shapes.
- Cut two $115 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes B to cut 4 shapes.
- Fabric Color 2 (dark purple): Cut two $55 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place right side up over shapes A to cut 4 shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (background/white):
- Cut two $11^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 8 "}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes B to cut 4 shapes.
- Cut two $53 / 4$ " $\times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $C$ to cut 8 shapes.
- Fabric Color 4 (light purple): Cut two $53 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 81}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $C$ to cut 8 shapes.

How to Sew the 4-color, 12" finished Whirling Star Block:
Read through assembly instructions before starting sewing. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed in pattern.

## Step 1



Sew piece $A$ to piece $C$ as shown to make $A / C$ unit. Make 8 total units. For 4-color block, make 4 units of each color combination.

Step 2


Sew piece $B$ to piece $C$ as shown to make B/C unit. Make 8 total units. For 4-color block, make 4 units of each color combination.

## Step 3



Sew $A / C$ unit from step 1 to $B / C$ unit from step 2 as shown to make A/C/B/C unit. Make 4 of each for a 4-color block.

Step 4


Repeat step 3 with other $A / C / B / C$ unit color combination. Make 4 of each for a 4-color block.

Step 5


Sew the two $A / C / B / C$ units together to create a quarter block. Make 4.

Step 6


Sew quarter blocks into rows, then sew rows together to complete block.

Step 7


Block should measure $12^{1 / 21} \times 12^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
