# CUTTING & YARDAGE

**Directional Fabric - has a definite direction - be aware of this when cutting**

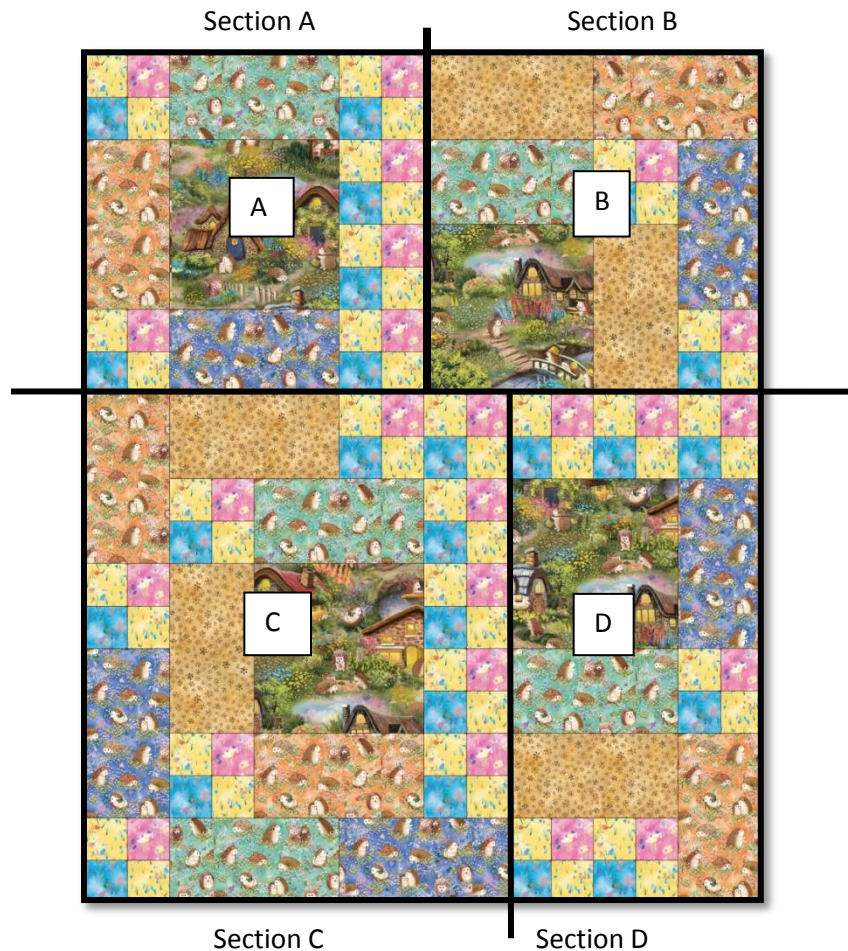
**wof- is width of fabric from selvage to selvage, approx 42"**

Your Choice Backing Batting 71 x 83	4 3/4 yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Backing - Cut two 83" x wof pieces</li> </ul>

Notions: Rulers and mat, rotary cutter. Threads and your favorite notions.

# PIECING THE BLOCKS



1/4" seam allowance used for all piecing

1. Stitch a 3 1/2" yellow strip to a 3 1/2" blue strip to make a strip set. Repeat.

Sub cut into twenty-four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" sections.

Stitch a 3 1/2" pink strip to a 3 1/2" yellow strip to make a strip set. Repeat.

Sub cut into twenty-four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" sections.

1. Stitch 24 four-patch units as shown.

2. Stitch sections A through D as follows:

**Section A** uses six four-patch units, one 12 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall rectangle each aqua and blue hedgehog, one 6 1/2" wide x 12 1/2" tall rectangle peach hedgehog and one village 12 1/2" square. Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into 24 1/2" x 24 1/2" Section A.

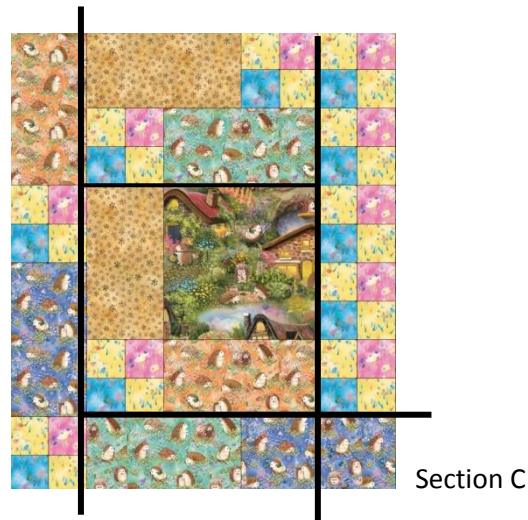
**Section B** uses two four-patch units, and one village 12 1/2" square. One 12 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall rectangle each peach and aqua hedgehog, one 6 1/2" wide x 12 1/2" tall rectangle blue hedgehog, two 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles tan paw print, and one village 12 1/2" square.

Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into 24 1/2" x 24 1/2" Section B.



Section B

**Section C** uses ten four-patch units, one peach, one blue and two aqua hedgehog 12 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall rectangles, one peach and one blue hedgehog 6 1/2" wide x 12 1/2" tall rectangles, two 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles tan paw print and one village 12 1/2" square. Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into 30 1/2" x 36 1/2" Section C.



**Section D** uses six four-patch units, one 12 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall rectangle aqua hedgehog, one each blue and peach hedgehog 6 1/2" wide x 12 1/2" tall rectangles, one 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle tan paw print and one village 12 1/2" . Stitch in rows, then stitch rows into 18 1/2" x 36 1/2" Section D.

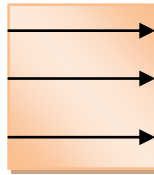
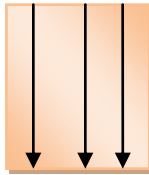


Sew **Section A** to **Section B** to make the 24 1/2" x 48 1/2" top row. Stitch **Section C** to **Section D** to make the 36 1/2" x 48 1/2" bottom row. Join the rows to complete the 48 1/2" x 60 1/2" quilt center.



# COMPLETING THE QUILT

It is best practice to measure quilt through several areas, averaging this amount and cutting borders to fit.



**1. Horizontal Borders:** Use four yellow 17 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall strips and two village 17 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall strips. Sew a village strip between two yellow strips to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**2. Vertical Borders:** Use two yellow 6 1/2" wide x 21 1/2" tall strips, four village 6 1/2" wide x 21 1/2" tall strips and four green 6 1/2" squares. Sew a yellow strip between two village strips and add a green square to each end to make a side border. Repeat. Stitch the borders to the sides of the quilt.

**3. Backing:** Stitch two lengths along selvages in a deep seam, about 1 1/2", then trim seam to 1/4" width. Press open. Trim to 71" x 83".

**4. Quilting:** Layer backing, batting and top. Quilt with walking foot in diagonal lines or in an all-over meander. Trim all edges even with top.










**5. Binding:** Stitch 8 strips together in continuous length at short ends on the bias, trim to 1/4" seam allowance, press open. Fold entire length in half, wrong sides together, press. Leave an excess of twelve inches and starting in the middle of one long side of trimmed quilt, stitch in 1/4" to 3/8" seam allowance. Check to be sure quilt will be a snug fit in the binding when it is turned to finish side.

Tip: Pin the binding in place to keep the seam flat and prevent rippling. I prefer to stitch the binding to the quilt back then turning it to the front allowing me to top stitch close to the folded edge in a clean finish.
