## Cutting Directions

WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage.
Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

## 24906 E - Grand Slam Large Squares

- Fussy-cut (8) $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares, centering the motif in each square.


## 24907 E - Grand Slam Small Squares

- Fussy-cut (4) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ player squares with cream backgrounds for Corner Star blocks, centering a motif in each square.
- Fussy-cut (4) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " player squares with blue and green backgrounds for Center Star blocks, centering a motif in each square.


## 24908 B - Blue Player Print

- Cut (2) $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips; recut into (8) $91 / 2$ " squares. - Cut (1) $53 / 4$ " x WOF strip; recut into (4) $53 / 4$ " squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 16 triangles.
- Cut (1) $37 / 8^{" \prime} \times$ WOF strip; recut into (6) $37 / 8^{" 1}$ squares and (1) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Cut (3) $37 / 8^{" 1}$ squares from top right to lower left and (3) $37 / 8$ " squares from top left to lower right to make 6 triangles each.
- Cut (1) $23 / 4$ x $\times$ WOF strip; recut into (15) $23 / 4$ " squares (16 squares total).


## 24908 E - Cream Player Print

- Cut (1) $91 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; recut into (1) $91 / 2$ " square, (4) $53 / 4$ " squares and (1) $23 / 4$ square. Cut the $53 / 4 "$ squares twice diagonally to make 16 triangles.
- Cut (1) $23 / 4$ x WOF strip; recut into (15) $23 / 4$ " squares (16 squares total).


## 24910 J - Bat Print

- Cut (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; recut into (10) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


## 24912 Y - Ball Print

-Cut (2) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 651 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips along length of fabric for outer border.

- Cut (2) $41 / 4$ " x remaining WOF strips; recut into (10) $41 / 4^{" 1}$ squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 40 triangles.
- Cut (4) $23 / 8$ " x remaining WOF strips; recut into (40) $23 / 8$ " squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 80 triangles.


## 24362 KE - Cream Scroll

- Cut (2) $3 / 4 \times$ WOF strips; recut into (8) $3 / 4 \times 41 / 2 "$ strips and (8) $3 / 4$ " x 5 " strips.
- Cut (2) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; recut into (14) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 28 triangles.
- Cut (2) $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips; recut into (10) $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares and (8) $31 / 2$ " squares. Cut the $41 / 4$ " squares twice diagonally to make 40 triangles.


## 24362 AS - Brown Scroll

-Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips; recut into (40) 2" squares.

## 24362 W - Navy Scroll

- Cut (8) 1" x WOF strips; recut into (16) 1 " x 9½" strips and (16) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut (2) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; recut into (8) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (12) $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut (4) $23 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; recut into (68) $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut these squares and the $23 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares from the previous step in half diagonally to make 160 triangles.
- Cut (3) $31 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; recut into (32) $311 \mathrm{~s}^{\prime \prime}$ squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 64 triangles.
- Cut (2) $3 / 4$ " x WOF strips; recut into (8) $3 / 4$ " x 5 " strips and (8) $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- Cut (6) $111 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for inner border.
- Cut (7) $21 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## 24909 E - Equipment Print (Backing Only)

- Cut (2) 79" x WOF backing pieces.


## Star Blocks

Note: Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance for all stitching.

1. Sew a $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " cream strip to opposite sides of each blue or green $41 / 2$ " Grand Slam small square. Press seams toward the squares. Stitch a $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5 "$ cream strip to the top and bottom to make (4) 5" x 5" dark framed centers. Press seams toward the squares. Repeat with $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ navy strips and the cream $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Grand Slam small squares to make 4 light framed centers.

2. Stitch a $31 / 8$ " navy triangle to the 2 short sides of each $53 / 4$ " cream player triangle to make (16) $23 / 4$ " x $5 "$ cream triangle units. Press seams toward navy triangles. Repeat with navy triangles and blue player triangles to make 16 blue triangle units. Note: The player triangles are directional. You will have 4 each top, bottom, left and right triangle units in each color.

3. Referring to the Center Star block drawing, sew a cream left triangle unit to the left edge of each dark framed center unit and a cream right triangle unit to the right edge to make (4) 5 " $\times 911 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center rows. Press seams toward the center units.
4. Stitch the cream top triangle units between (2) $23 / 4$ " cream player squares to make (4) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top rows, keeping the print in the squares upright to match the triangle units. Press seams toward the squares. Repeat with the cream bottom triangle units to make (4) $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bottom rows.
5. Sew each center row between a top row and a bottom row to make (4) $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Center Star blocks. Press seams toward the top and bottom rows.

6. Repeat steps $3-5$ with light framed center units, blue triangle units and blue $23 / 4$ " squares to make (4) $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Corner Star blocks.

## Background Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ navy square and $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream square.
2. Place a marked navy square right sides together on the right bottom corner of a $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue player square. Sew on the marked line. Trim seam allowance $1 / 4$ " out from the stitched line. Press the navy triangle open. Repeat with a marked cream square on the navy corner to complete (1) $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $91 / 2$ " Background A block. Repeat to make a second block.

3. Repeat to make 2 each Background B, C and D blocks paying careful attention to the placement of the pieced corners.

## Framed Player Blocks

1. Sew a 1 " $\times 81 / 2$ " navy strip to the left and right edges of each $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Grand Slam large square. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch a 1 " x $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ navy strip to the top and bottom to make (8) $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Framed Player blocks. Press seams toward the strips.

## Baseball Diamond Blocks

1. Sew a $23 / 8$ " ball print triangle to the 2 short sides of a $41 / 4$ " cream triangle to make a 2 " x $31 / 2$ " cream triangle unit. Press seams toward the ball print triangles. Repeat to make 40 units. Repeat with $23 / 8$ " navy triangles and $41 / 4$ " ball print triangles to make (40) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ ball triangle units.



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2. Stitch a ball triangle unit to the top of each cream triangle unit to make (40) $31 / 2{ }^{2} \times 31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ side units. Press seams toward the cream triangle units.

3. Sew a $23 / 8$ " navy triangle to 2 adjacent edges of each 2 " brown square to make 40 pieced triangles. Press seams toward the triangles.


Pieced Triangle Make 40
4. Add a $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ blue player triangle to the long side of 12 pieced triangles to make (12) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue corner units. Press seams toward the blue triangles. Add a $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cream triangle to the remaining pieced triangles to make (28) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " cream corner units. Press seams toward the cream triangles.

5. Sew a side unit to the left and right edges of each $31 / 2$ " bat square to make (10) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ center rows. Press seams toward the bat squares. Stitch a side unit between 2 cream corner units to make a $31 / 2$ " $\times 91 / 2$ " cream row. Press seams toward the corner units. Repeat to make 10 cream rows.

6. To make the Baseball Diamond A block, sew a blue corner unit to opposite sides of a side unit to make the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top row, keeping the print in the blue triangles upright in the row. Press seams toward the corner units. Sew a center row between the top row and a cream row to complete the $9 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Baseball Diamond A block. Press seams toward the center row.

7. Repeat step 6 to make the top or bottom row and complete 2 each Baseball Diamond B-E blocks and 1 Baseball Diamond F block, referring to the diagrams for placement of the blue corner units and keeping the blue player print upright in each block.

Quilt Assembly
Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps. Background blocks and Baseball Diamond blocks in the diagram are lettered to make placement easier.

1. Join 2 Corner Star blocks and 1 block each Background A, Baseball Diamond A and Background $B$ to make row 1. Press seams to the right to complete the $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ row.
2. Join 1 block each Background A, Baseball Diamond B, Framed Player, Baseball Diamond C and Background $B$ to make row 2. Press seams to the left.
3. Join 1 block each Center Star, Baseball Diamond B and Baseball Diamond C and 2 Framed Player blocks to make row 3 . Press seams to the right.
4. Join 2 Framed Player blocks, 2 Center Star blocks and the $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream player square to make row 4 . Press seams to the left.
5. Continue to join 5 blocks to make each row 5-7, pressing odd-numbered rows to the right and even-numbered rows to the left.
6. Join the rows to complete the $451 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.
7. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF navy strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) $631 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stitch the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
8. Stitch the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 651 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ball print strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ball print strips to the top and bottom to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
9. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the edges to make a 61 " $\times 79$ " backing piece.
10. Layer the top with the backing and a $61^{\prime \prime} \times 79^{\prime \prime}$ batting piece. Quilt as desired. Trim edges even with the top.
11. Prepare navy scroll binding and bind edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
