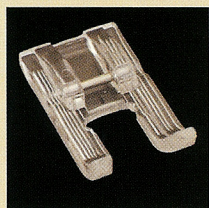
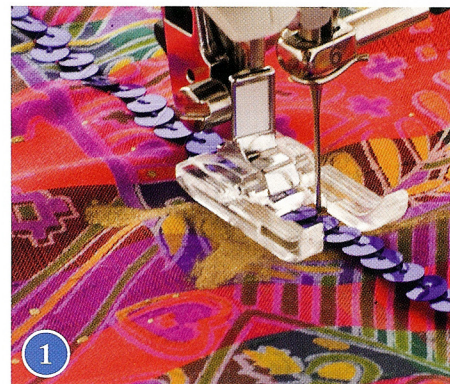


# couching sequins

*Using monofilament thread, couch sequins to the right side of your fabric.*

1. Stabilize your fabric with tear-away stabilizer. Draw a line on your fabric using the air-soluble marking pen. Place the sequins under the foot with the “grain” of the sequins toward you. You want the foot to be able to slide smoothly over the sequins as you sew. Thread your machine with the monofilament thread. Adjust the stitch width and length so the zigzag stitch covers the width of the sequins and a long stitch length. Sew slowly guiding the sequins under the foot. (#1)
2. After attaching the sequins, carefully adjust the stitch so the thread slides under the individual sequins.



**Open Toe Foot**

**Stitch:** Zigzag

**Width:** 7.0mm

**Length:** 3.5 - 5.0mm

**Tension:** Pre-set

**Fabric, needles, notions required:**

*Fabric of choice; universal, size 80/12; monofilament for needle and all-purpose polyester for bobbin; sequins; tear-away stabilizer; air-soluble marking pen*

**TIP**

*Make sure you are sewing with the sequins flat overlapping toward you so they don't catch on the foot. Once you have completed stitching, “wiggle” the individual sequins so the monofilament thread is hidden under each sequin.*
