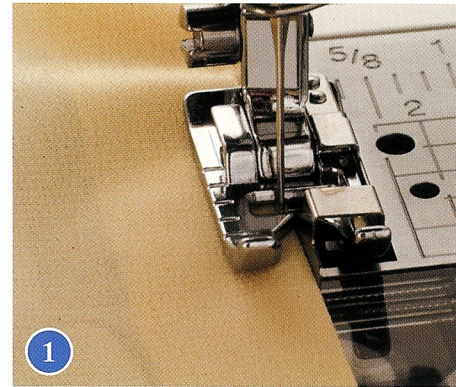


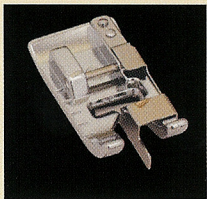
edge finishes — fine edge

A very delicate edge finish used to finish a single layer of fabric. This fine edge finish is perfect for heirloom or couture sewing.

1. Fold back approximately 1" along the edge to be finished; press. Place the folded edge against the metal blade on the edge joining foot. Carefully zigzag allowing the right needle swing to fall off the right edge of the fabric. The left swing should just catch the edge. (#1)



2. After completing the edge, carefully trim the excess fabric from the reverse side close to the stitching. Use very sharp appliqué or embroidery scissors watching so you don't clip into the fabric. (#2)



Edge Joining Foot

Stitch: Zigzag

Width: 2.5mm

Length: 1.0mm

Tension: Pre-set

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Fine fabrics of choice such as linen, silk, or cotton batiste; universal needle, size 70/10; heirloom sewing or silk thread for needle and for bobbin; appliqué or embroidery scissors

TIP

This elegant edge finish is a beautiful detail on fine silk scarves or ruffles. The delicate finish is also very sturdy and strong. Be sure to use a fine heirloom or silk thread when sewing this finish.
