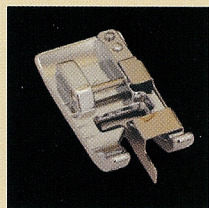
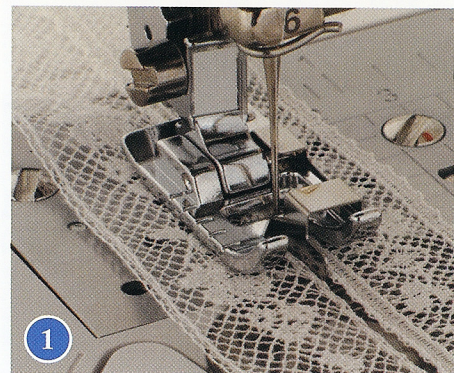


heirloom — attaching lace to lace

Attach lace to lace using this very easy heirloom technique.

1. Prepare the laces with spray starch. Position one piece on each side of the metal blade on the presser foot. Adjust the zigzag width, if necessary, to just stitch into the header on each piece of lace. Sew. (#1)

Stitch: Zigzag

Width: Pre-set

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Edging or insertion lace; universal needle, size 70/10; rayon or heirloom embroidery thread for needle and bobbin; spray starch

FOOT FACTS

The edge joining foot is a very versatile foot. It is similar to the blindhem foot however the metal blade extends only to the needle hole allowing you to use a wide variety of stitches.
