

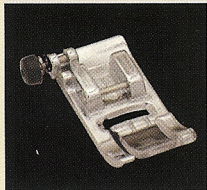
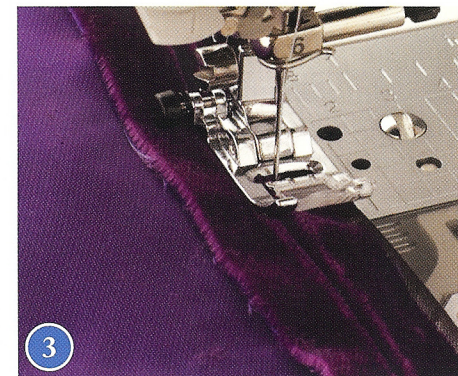
seams — Seams Great™

A seam finish used on fine fabrics which ravel heavily.

1. This seam treatment is good for velvet as it keeps the edges of the seam allowance from raveling. Sew your 5/8" seam as usual. (#1)



2. Open out the seam allowance so one layer is under the presser foot. Wrap the Seams Great™ around the edge and take a few stitches. As you sew, pull the seam tape slightly and it will wrap around the edge. Sew making sure the edge of the seam allowance does not slide out of the tape. (#2 & #3)



Standard Foot

Stitch: Straight

Width: Pre-set

Length: Pre-set

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Velvet or very loosely-woven fabrics;
universal needle, size 80/12; all-
purpose sewing thread for needle
and bobbin; Seams Great™

FOOT FACTS

When sewing on velvet, choose the presser foot that works the best for you. Some choices might include the standard, the roller, or the Teflon-coated feet. The fabric easily shows the imprint of the feed dogs or any upper teeth/rollers so select the foot carefully,
