

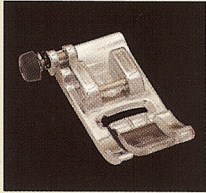
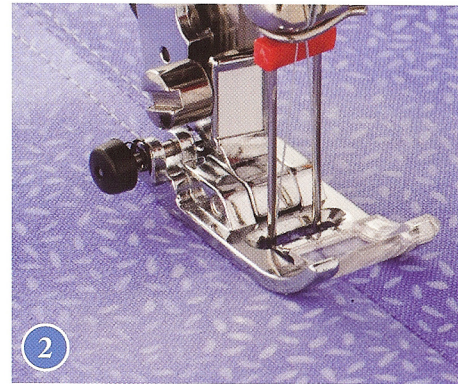
# seams — twin needle

*This two-step seam provides symmetrical detail for the seam on the right side.*

1. Sew a traditional 5/8" seam. Press the seam open. (#1)



2. Insert a twin needle and from the right side, center the seam under the standard foot using the mark on the foot to guide. As you sew, a straight stitch will form on either side of the seam for detail. (#2)



**Standard Foot**

**Stitch:** *Straight*

**Width:** *Pre-set*

**Length:** *Pre-set*

**Tension:** *Pre-set*

**Fabric, needles, notions required:**

*Fabrics of choice; universal needle, size 80/12 and twin needle, size 3.0, 4.0, or 6.0mm; all-purpose sewing thread for needles and bobbin*

**TIP**

*Be sure to choose a twin needle that is appropriate to the fabric you are sewing on. Remember as the distance becomes greater between the needles, the actual size of the needles also increase. Also do not use a twin needle wider than the widest stitch width possible on your sewing machine.*
