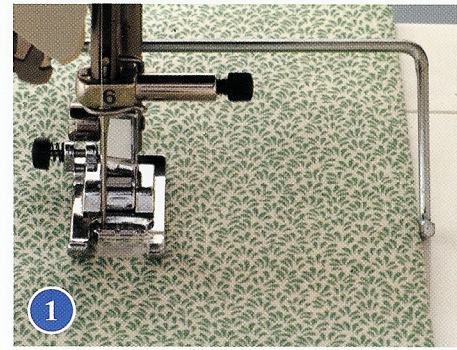


# tucks — centered

*Special tucks with two edges made by centering the tuck over the seam.*

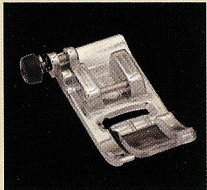
1. For centered tucks, determine how wide you want the finished tucks to be. For a doubled and centered tuck, add the additional amount needed for the top tuck. Insert the quilting bar to keep your sewing even and sew the first seam. (#1)



2. Move the quilting bar and sew the second seam. Center the first seam. Then center the second seam over the first. Press both tucks in place. Baste the edges to hold the tucks in place. (#2)



3. If more detail is desired, sew a decorative stitch down the center of both tucks.



**Standard Foot**

**Stitch:** *Straight and  
Decorative Stitch*

**Width:** *Pre-set*

**Length:** *Pre-set*

**Tension:** *Pre-set*

**Fabric, needles, notions required:**

*Fabrics of choice; universal needle, size 80/12; all-purpose sewing thread for needle and bobbin; rayon or cotton embroidery thread*

**TIP**

*When pressing centered tucks, use a dowel to open and press each tuck before pressing the edges down.*
