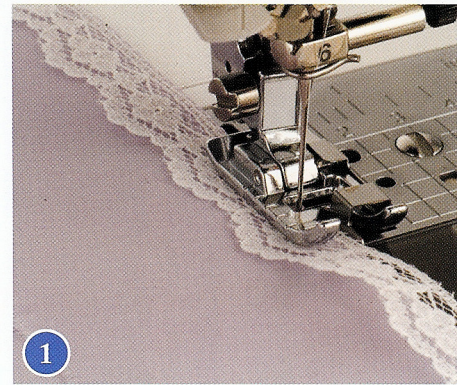


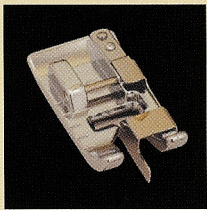
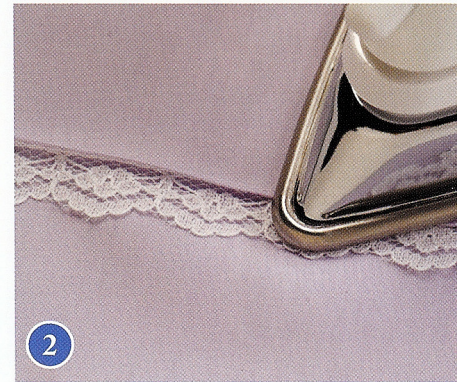
tucks — lace

Sew lace to the edge of tucks at the same time.

1. Measure and mark the placement for each tuck. Press with wrong sides together. Layer the straight edge of the lace on the fold of the fabric and place both against the blade of the edge joining foot. Adjust the needle position to make a tuck and sew the lace at the same time. (#1)



2. Open the tuck and press the tuck and the lace to one side. Repeat the process for as many tucks as desired. (#2)



Edge Joining Foot

Stitch: Straight

Width: Pre-set

Length: Pre-set

Tension: Pre-set

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Fabrics of choice; edging lace; universal needle, size 80/12; all-purpose sewing thread for needle and bobbin

TIP

When measuring and sewing lace tucks, remember to allow a space for the width of the lace between tucks before stitching another tuck.
