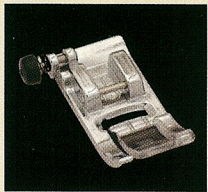
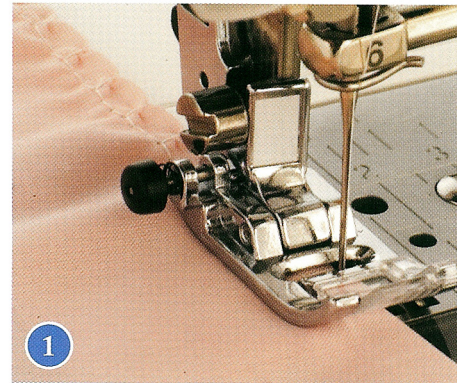


tucks —picot or shell

Tucks with a shell-like or picot edge made by the stitch used.

1. Measure and press the tucks wrong sides together. Center the standard foot over the folded edge. Select the shell tuck edge stitch and begin to sew. The right needle swing should fall off the edge of the fabric. The zigzag stitch should pull in creating the scallop-like edge. (#1)
2. Press the picot or shell tucks to one side.



Standard Foot

Stitch: *Shell Tuck Edge Stitch*

Width: *7.0mm*

Length: *2.5-3.0mm*

Tension: *Pre-set*

Fabric, needles, notions required:

Lightweight fabrics of choice; universal needle, size 80/12; all-purpose sewing thread for needle and bobbin
