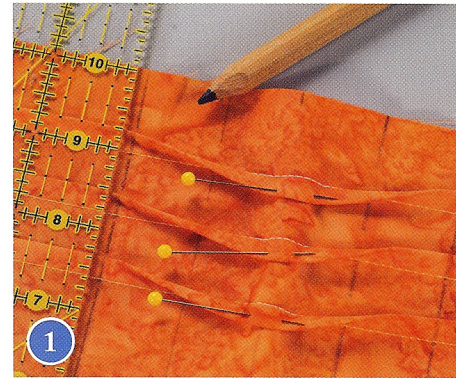


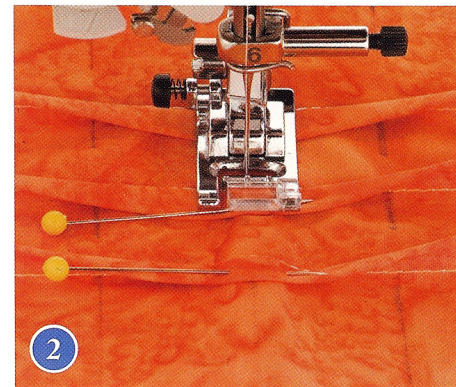
tucks — wave

Simple tucks sewn across the fabric and then stitched down in a back and forth manner making waves.

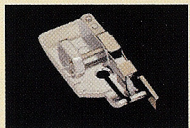
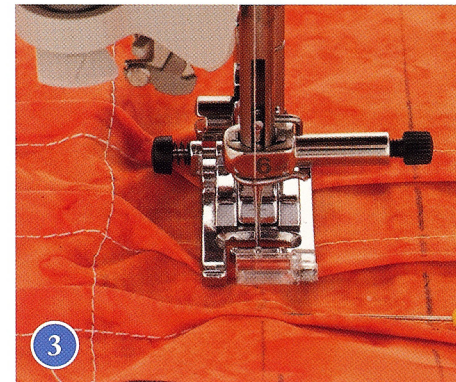
1. Following the instructions for traditional tucks, measure and stitch tucks across the fabric. Draw lines across the fabric to make the waves. Alternate pinning the tucks up and down. (#1)



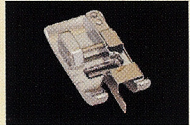
2. Following the drawn lines, stitch in the same direction on every other line. (#2)



3. Flip the direction of the tucks and stitch on the remaining lines making waves. (#3)

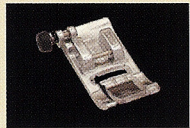


**1/4" Quilting
